<p><b>Alaska –</b></p> <p>An Act relating to personal information; the privacy of personal information; and the collection, sale, sharing, deletion, correction, and use of personal information (<a href="#">HB222</a>)</p> <p><i>Consumer Data Privacy Act</i> (<a href="#">HB159</a>)</p>	<p><b>Arizona –</b></p> <p>Relating to personal data and processing security standards (<a href="#">HB2790</a>)</p>
<p><b>California –</b></p> <p>Modifications to include in the definition of data broker a business that knowingly collects and shares, as defined, certain personal information to third parties and transfer all authority and responsibilities under the provisions relating to data broker registration from the Attorney General to the CCPA. (<a href="#">SB1059</a>)</p>	<p><b>Connecticut –</b></p> <p>An Act concerning personal data privacy and online monitoring (<a href="#">SB6</a>)</p>
<p><b>Georgia –</b></p> <p><i>Georgia Computer Data Privacy Act</i> (<a href="#">SB394</a>)</p>	<p><b>Hawaii –</b></p> <p>Establishes a framework to regulate controllers and processors with access to personal consumer data. Establishes penalties. Establishes a new consumer privacy special fund (<a href="#">SB2797</a>)</p> <p><i>Hawaii Consumer Privacy Act</i> (<a href="#">HB2051</a>)</p>
<p><b>Indiana –</b></p> <p>Consumer privacy. Requires businesses to disclose certain information to consumers. Outlines different requests a consumer may make with businesses regarding the consumer's personal information. Assigns enforcement of consumer privacy law to the Indiana division of consumer protection. Provides certain business exceptions (<a href="#">HB1261</a>)</p>	<p><b>Massachusetts –</b></p> <p><i>Massachusetts Information Privacy Act</i> (<a href="#">SB2867</a>)</p>
<p><b>Maryland –</b></p> <p>Establishing the Workgroup on Online Consumer Personal Information Privacy to review current practices of business entities relating to the collection, use, storage, disclosure, analysis, deletion, and modification of online personal information of consumers in the State; and requiring the Workgroup to report its findings and recommendations, including any recommended legislation, to the Governor and certain committees of the General (<a href="#">SB11</a>)</p>	<p><b>Michigan –</b></p> <p><i>Consumer Privacy Act</i> (<a href="#">HB5989</a>)</p>

<p><b>New York –</b></p> <p><i>New York Privacy Act (<a href="#">A680</a>)</i></p> <p>Relates to establishing the online consumer protection act (<a href="#">A405</a>)</p> <p>Digital Fairness Act (<a href="#">A6042</a>)</p> <p>Allows consumers the right to request from businesses the categories of personal information a business has sold or disclosed to third parties (<a href="#">A3709</a>, <a href="#">S567</a>)</p> <p><i>The Right to Know Act of 2021</i> (<a href="#">A400</a>, <a href="#">S1349</a>)</p> <p><i>Online Consumer Protection Act</i> (<a href="#">SB2886</a>)</p> <p>Relates to enacting the New York Privacy Act (<a href="#">S6701</a>)</p> <p><i>It's Your Data Act</i> (<a href="#">A3586</a>, <a href="#">S4021</a>)</p>	<p><b>Oklahoma –</b></p> <p><i>Oklahoma Computer Data Privacy Act of 2022</i> (<a href="#">HB2968</a>)</p> <p><i>Oklahoma Computer Data Privacy Act</i> (<a href="#">HB2969</a>)</p> <p><i>Personal Data Protection Act</i> (<a href="#">HB3447</a>)</p>
